Dear member of Alfa Romeo 6C 2300-2500 International Register,

the fifth revival of Coppa Milano Sanremo will take place from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> March 2007: in order to celebrate the 80 years' anniversary of the Alfa Romeo 6C model built in 1927 by Vittorio Jano, we wish to give special prominence to a wide selection of all models of Alfa Romeo 6C.

For this reason, we decided to grant a 500,00 Euros discount on the entry fee to all members of Alfa Romeo 6C 2300-2500 International Register. As a result, entry fee covering accommodation in Deluxe Hotels will be 2,600 Euros, and entry fee for Superior Hotels will be 2,100 Euros.

Participants have the option of registering on Thursday 8, in order to have more time to enjoy using the famous Monza race track on Friday morning.

As usual, Coppa Milano Sanremo offers the option of competing in the touring class regularity trials, or just attending the event.

On Saturday the route will take the cars through the Lomellina hills and the Gavi area, where we will stop off for a break in the splendid wine cellars of Monterotondo Resort to enjoy the area's wonderful food. We then head for the scenic Scoffera pass, and down to the magnificent coast around the gulf of Portofino. Back by popular demand is a stop-off in Genoa, where lunch on Sunday will be hosted in the Maggior Consiglio hall in the impressive Palazzo Ducale.

The marvellous route along the coast and through the mountains offers breathtaking views of the Italian Riviera and the city of Genoa. The via Aurelia will then lead you through picturesque villages overlooking the sea to Sanremo, where the event ends on Sunday afternoon. As in previous years the organisers have taken particular care over the selection of hotels, menus and halls for the gala dinners.
